Soori High Line reveals its striking vertical facade

The High Line-adjacent, private-pool sporting condos have topped out, and are now being fitted with their curtain wall, well on their way to an anticipated 2017 completion, new photos by *Field Condition* [have revealed](#). Soori High Line, as the project is known, features a total of 31 apartments that range in size from one bedrooms to five bedrooms. They're being offered up as singles, duplexes, and triplexes, and [16](#)

of them come with heated, salt water swimming pools, which is apparently a trademark of architect Soo K. Chan.

Several of the apartments in this 11-story building are already in contract, and of those listed on the market, prices range from \$3.5 million for a two-bedroom and go up to \$15.1 million for a three-bedroom, three-bathroom unit.



Developer Siras Oriel will also offer residents a spa, steam, and sauna, along with a residents lounge and a library. Apartments will come fitted with floor to ceiling windows, radiant floor heating, and fireplaces in every living room, among other features.
